






Logo description

Responsibilities include caring for children and tutoring them in English (up to 35 hours per week), along with activities like school pick-up and creating educational games.







Corinne came to China in February 2024 and spended 5 months with her ideal family in Shanghai too. They created their own memories together. She will return to China if she has the chance.






