# Program Overview



Duration: 3-12 months.



Participants live with carefully selected host families in cities like Shanghai, Beijing, Taiyuan, and suburban areas.



Responsibilities include caring for children and tutoring them in English (up to 35 hours per week), along with activities like school pick-up and creating educational games.

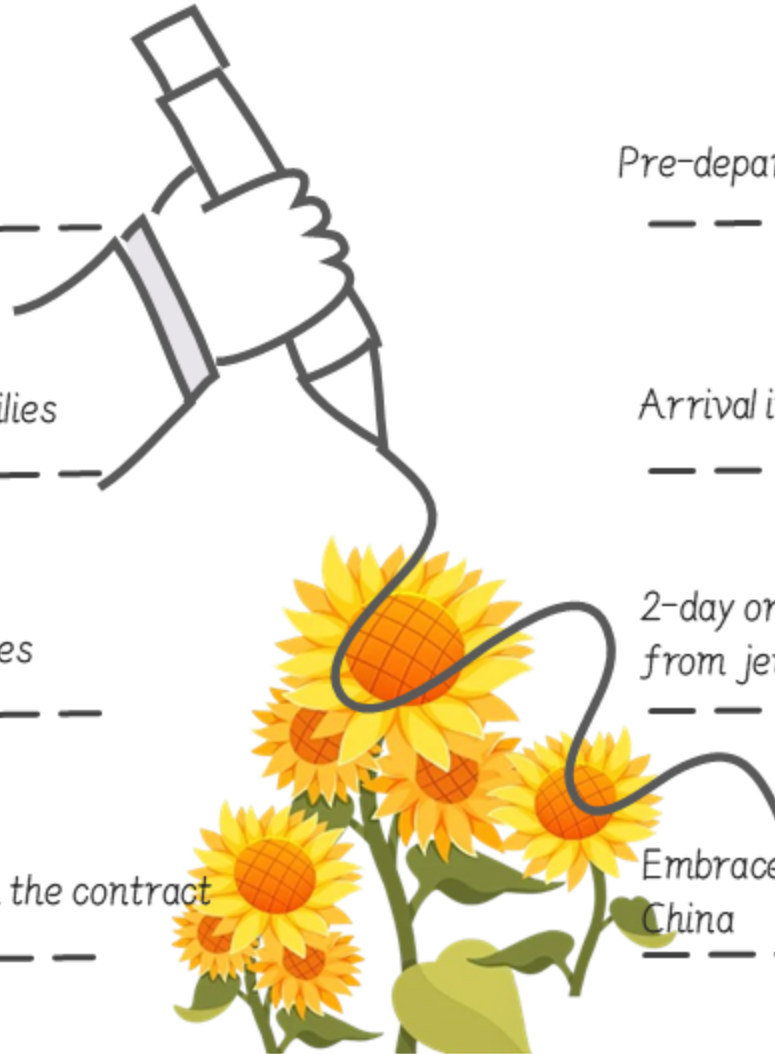

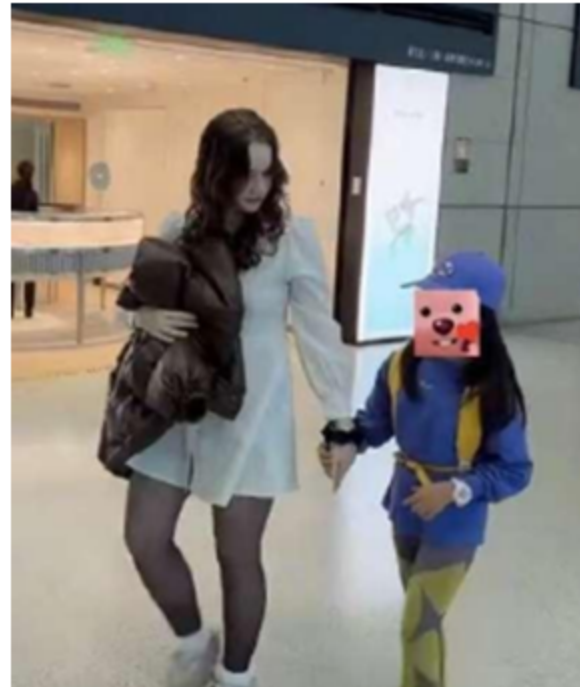
